


# Fun and Games 2

## Use it or Lose it!

Find out how your travel choices affect climate change with this two-player game. Follow the instructions on the back to cut out and make the game. Always ask for an adult's help when using scissors!

### To play the game:

1. Turn the game around so that 'TOP' is facing away from you, then push your index finger and thumb from each hand into the 4 slots and hold the game shut, so only the travel choices can be seen.
2. Ask a friend to choose a travel method and then use the game to spell out its name - opening the game upwards for the first letter, sideways for the second, upwards for the third and so on.
3. Hold the game open wherever you end up and ask your friend whether they want to 'USE IT' or 'LOSE IT'! If they think the travel method they've chosen is good, they choose 'USE IT'. If they think it is bad for climate change, they choose 'LOSE IT'.
4. Again, spell out the words they choose by opening the game upwards and sideways repeatedly.
5. Hold the game open wherever you end up and ask them to choose a colour.
6. Open up this coloured flap and read what is written inside!



**BIKE** (TOP)

**USE IT!**  
DISASTER!!  
Your house is washed away by floods!

**LOSE IT!**  
OH NO!!  
Ice melts at the north pole - polar bears lose their home!

**CAR** (TOP)

**LOSE IT!**  
BRILLIANT!!  
Your family are the best energy savers in town!

**USE IT!**  
WOW!!  
A new wind turbine is named after you!

**WALK** (TOP)

**LOSE IT!**  
WELL DONE!!  
Win Energy Champion Award for fantastic energy cuts!

You invent a new way to save energy!

**PLANE** (TOP)

**LOSE IT!**  
NO DINNER!!  
Hotter weather dries up the land and stops grow-  
food from

**USE IT!**  
STORM ALERT!!  
Extreme wind, rain and flash floods on the way!

## How to make the game:

1. cut out following the border
2. Fold inwards on dotted line, so all corners meet at the circle in the centre.
3. Turn over, colour-side down and fold corners in to the centre again.
4. Turn over, colour-side down again and fold in half, following the dotted lines inside. Do this twice - once following the vertical dotted line and once following the horizontal line.
5. With colour-side down, push fingers and thumbs under corner flaps and open out. You're ready to play!
