Beginning with a keynote speaker, the event will also use a range of participatory sessions. It will also feature the **PlanLoCaL model**, a large-scale model of a town demonstrating how renewable energy technologies work, and the **PlanLoCaL films**, which include case studies and information on how to set up renewable energy projects.

The morning will focus on how communities can get involved in local plan making, with the

afternoon looking at renewable energy technologies, climate change adaptation, community engagement, and funding issues.
